ORDER FOR DRUG/ALCOHOL TESTING

THIS MATTER came before the Court as a result of the filing of a request by one of the parties which seeks a court-ordered drug/alcohol evaluation. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that both parties shall immediately submit to the following specified drug/alcohol testing pursuant to LSA RS 9:331.1 and LSA R.S. 46:236.5.C.3.j and the Local Rules of the Fourth Judicial District Court:

1. **Furnish urine sample to 4th JDC Probation Office for immediate testing (Apresumptive test@)**
 2. **Furnish urine sample to 4th JDC Probation Office for submission to an approved laboratory for gas chromatography testing if the Apresumptive test@ indicates the need for further testing.**
 3. **Other:** _____
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4. **Pay to the 4th JDC Probation Office the sum of \$15 per individual tested, by money order or attorney firm check:**
 - a. **Each party shall pay his/her own test costs**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff, and Defendant, and the minor child[ren] at issue in this proceeding, submit to and cooperate in the evaluation, testing, or interview by the 4th JDC Probation Office and that the parties shall sign any releases requested by the 4th JDC Probation Office or its designees to facilitate the drug/alcohol paraprofessional-s ability to gather information, other than information which is privileged under the attorney-client privilege, which he or she reasonably believes to be necessary for a thorough evaluation;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall return for the conclusion of the Hearing Officer Conference on the ____ day of _____, 20__ at ____ o-clock am / pm in the office of Hearing Officer _____, at which time the test results will be addressed, as well as the issue of further referrals for counseling and/or substance abuse treatment if appropriate, together will any other remaining issues.
